<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> The hot water at the 3-compartment sink is observed turned off for leak repairs. Immediately make repairs.

**Violation Description:** An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113953(c), 114099.2(b), 114101(a), 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)

**27. FOOD SEPARATED AND PROTECTED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Discontinue the practice of storing salad bowls or any food containers on top of each other without any cover/lid between them. Observed salad bowls stored on top of each other without any cover between them in the Teppan waitress station reach-in refrigerator.

Observed rice cooker very close to the employee hand washing sink in the Dining waitress station area.

**Violation Description:** All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

**35. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; CLEAN; GOOD REPAIR, CAPACITY**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Repair the cold prep table in the kitchen to maintain food temperature at 41 degrees F or below. This unit maintains temperature at 50 degrees F at the time of inspection.

**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> The concentration of the chlorine sanitizer water is observed above 200 ppm in the Dining waitress station at the time of inspection.

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Debris buildup observed on the floor, especially at corners, in the storage area.

Water and debris buildup observed on the floor in the washer area.

**Violation Description:** The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
