POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Maintain cold holding temperatures of potentially hazardous foods at or below 41 degrees. Observed temperature of carafe of milk at 53 degrees, waffle batter at 58 degrees. Ensure all potentially hazardous foods are discarded within 4 hours if not held in safe temperature range. Once out of temperature, recommend exchanging for another containers. Recommend mixing waffle batter with ice cold water prior to placing in dispenser.

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure utensils are sanitized with quaternary ammonium measuring between 200-400 ppm. Observed quaternary ammonium measuring 100 ppm in 3 compartment sink. Prior to washing any utensils, provide a minimum warm water temperature of 100 degrees for manual warewashing. Observed temperature of wash water in 3 compartment sink at 94 degrees. No active warewashing observed at time of inspection.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

(d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location.
