<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Discontinue storing food items in handwash sink to make accessible for handwashing.  Observed bag of food inside handwash sink.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**32. FOOD PROPERLY LABELED & HONESTLY PRESENTED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Properly label all repackaged foods. Provide common name of product, ingredients in descending order if more than 2, name and location of distributor, and net weight.  Observed repackaged nuts, seeds, and jamaica flowers without labeling.

**Violation Description:** Any food is misbranded if its labeling is false or misleading, if it is offered for sale under the name of another food, or if it is an imitation of another food for which a definition and standard of identity has been established by regulation. (114087, 114089, 114089.1(a, b), 114090, 114093.1) Bulk food available for consumer self-service must have an information label, sign, and/or other method of notification that includes the label information. (114089) Prepackaged food must bear a label that complies with the labeling requirements as prescribed by the Sherman Food, Drug and Cosmetic Law. (114089 and 114089(a))  
 Restaurants must provide a brochure placed at the point of sale that includes at least calories, sodium, saturated fat, and carbohydrates information per menu item. For sit-down restaurants, the information must be provided at the table. Drive-thrus are required to have the brochures available upon request and have a notice of the availability at the point of sale. (114094)

**35. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; CLEAN; GOOD REPAIR, CAPACITY**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Clean meat slicer between uses. Ensure meat slicer is broken down and clean and sanitized minimally every 4 hours. Observed meat debris on meat slicer.  Use only approved, cleanable shelf liners in walk in. Observed cardboard used to line shelves in walk in.

**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Ensure scoop handles are stored out of food products.  Observed scoop handles stored in bulk containers of rice and beans.

**Violation Description:** All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)



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**38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Provide vapor proof light covers in walk in coolers.  Observed missing.
	Not In Compliance	

**Violation Description:** Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

**43. TOILET FACILITIES: PROPERLY CONSTRUCTED, SUPPLIED, CLEANED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Provide restroom supplies from dispenser.  Observed roll of toilet tissue not in dispenser.

**Violation Description:** Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary and in good repair for use by employees and patrons. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting, self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. Location of toilet facilities used by patrons shall not be located to pass through food preparation, food storage, or utensil washing areas. (114250, 114250.1, 114276)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Clean and maintain walls on a routine basis.  Observed food debris build up on wall above and beside handwash sink.
	Not In Compliance	

**Violation Description:** The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

Please note that it is the responsibility of the operator to ensure a copy of the most recent health inspection is received.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
