Inspector Comments: A re-inspection was conducted at this facility to verify compliance with the violations written on previous report dated 04-01-14.

-During the re-inspection, tested autoclave with the approved sterilization integrator and passed. However, facility does not yet have the documentation for that a spore test has been conducted. Owner already obtained packet and just needs to send it to the lab in order to confirm results. Once these results are sent back to the owner, the records shall be emailed to the Health Department for verification.

-Continue working on labeling all instrument packets once the instruments have gone through the autoclave. Owner stated that he is using disposable instruments and the autoclave is used minimally. Observed disposable instruments in the facility that would indicate that this method is used.

-Currently, the owner is taking the sharps container to the Fire Department. Facility shall comply with regulation and the sharps waste should either be removed from the site by a mail-back-system or have an approved hauler remove the waste. Owner will provide verification within 1 week.

-Because there is no handwash sink in the sterilization room, facility must install one. However, if the owner goes to 100% disposable instruments then the site could remain this way. During the inspection, the owner indicated that going 100% disposable would be best and that is what he will do to prevent installation of the hand sink in the sterilization room.

-Owner has worked on the aftercare and consent forms. However, more information is required. Explained in detail to the owner what information is missing and how that could be incorporated into his forms. Also, gave him our website www.sbcounty.gov/dehs where he can go and download the forms that are ready for use.

-Owner stated that business is very slow and he is the only one that works at this site. He let go of the other artist that was working with him. Owner stated that he will not be renewing the Health Permit that expires on 12-31-14 because he will stop tattooing and focus on his art and t-shirt sales. Until then, ensure that facility is in compliance with all the rules and regulations required by the County and the State.
