Inspector Comments: Received complaint; complainant alleged that the manager stated the workers do not need food worker cards. Complainant alleged that facility does not change mop water. Complainant alleged that facility recycles salads. Complainant alleged that facility changes expiration dates on food.

During complaint investigation on 05-30-14, observed multiple valid original copies of food managers' certificates, as well as current, valid San Bernardino County food worker cards for all employees (three employees were new within the week; manager stated they will bring their cards in by next week; observed current valid food worker cards for all other employees.) Therefore, facility is in compliance with food worker card requirements, since new employees have two (2) weeks from start date to provide food worker cards.

Observed a mop bucket full of soapy water. Water was not yet dirty / soiled. Manager stated that the mop water is changed twice per shift.

Manager stated that if any customer returns food, that the food is discarded. Manager stated that they do not change expiration dates on food.

Ensure that the three new employees provide valid, current San Bernardino County food worker cards within two (2) weeks of start date.
