**Inspector Comments:** This department received a complaint alleging a piercing that was conducted at this facility became infected after cleaning it. Other allegations include, drug and alcohol consumption and forging of Body Art Practitioner registrations at this facility.

**Violation Description:** A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

**Overall Inspection Comments**

This department received a complaint alleging a piercing that was conducted at this facility became infected after cleaning it. Other allegations include, drug and alcohol consumption and forging of Body Art Practitioner registrations at this facility.

**FINDINGS:**

An investigation regarding allegations against this facility was conducted on this date. Inspector conducted a visual inspection of the facility. No evidence of drugs or alcohol was observed. Spoke with the owner of the body art facility, Omar Ibarra, who stated that on June 23rd. it was his birthday and a friend came by the shop with a 6-pack of beers. Omar stated the shop was closed and that the drinking took place after hours of operation. Owner denied having drugs in the facility. He recalled that a few weeks ago a box of Alconox sanitizer fell over and spilled on the counter. Employees made a comment that it looked like cocaine and a few may have taken pictures. When asked about the picture submitted per complainant, he stated he did not recognize the items shown. No complaints were received by the shop regarding infections of previously conducted piercings. During the investigation, two of the four body art practitioner registrations were found to be expired. No evidence of forged documents was observed at this time.

Unable to validate this compliant based on the findings.
