



Inspector Comments: Received complaint; complainant alleged that there were many children in diapers when they visited the park. Complainant stated that the park has signs posted that children need to be in water diapers, but that many children were in regular diapers. Complainant alleged that the 3-foot and lazy river pools were very cloudy / had poor water clarity. Complainant alleged that the restrooms and changing areas were not clean. Complainant alleged that no trash is provided and used sanitary products were lying on the ground. Complainant alleged that a family member experienced diarrhea the day after visiting the park.

During complaint investigation on 08-05-14, observed that the restrooms were adequately stocked with paper towels, toilet paper, and soap in dispensers. Observed that trash cans were also supplied at the restrooms. Did not observe any sanitary products on the floor in the women's restroom. Observed that the water clarity was good in pools.

Operator stated that the restrooms are checked / cleaned every thirty minutes.

Complaint is now closed. Note: routine inspections were also conducted on this date. See other inspection reports for more details.
