<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Chickens were observed on poles resting on floor above puddles of waste water / blood. Product was at 60°F for extended period of time. It was condemned for time temperature abuse. Twenty three whole chickens were discarded.

**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

**4. PROPER EATING, TASTING, DRINKING OR TOBACCO USE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Open employee drink is observed stored on or above a food/utensil contact surface. A food employee may drink from a closed beverage container if the container is handled to prevent contamination of the employee's hands, the container, nonprepackaged food, and food contact surfaces. In general, an employee's beverage container should not be placed on or directly above a food contact surface. Employee water cup was observed beside rice hot hold unit.

**Violation Description:** Employees shall not eat, drink, or use tobacco in non-designated areas where contamination may result. (113977) An employee shall not use a utensil to taste food more than once without being properly washed, rinsed and sanitized between uses. (113976)

**6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Obstructed, inaccessible, improper use of, or unclean handwashing sink. Box of rotten tomatoes were observed in kitchen hand wash sink.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**35. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; CLEAN; GOOD REPAIR, CAPACITY**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Provide cleaning to stove and it support stand.  Repair the food preparation refrigerator in order that it holds cold perishable foods at 41°F or less. Containerized food inside unit was at 46°F, upper well foods at 49°F.

**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**39. THERMOMETERS PROVIDED AND ACCURATE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> A thermometer was added to the counter top refrigerator at the sale point that was missing a thermometer.

**Violation Description:** An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)

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**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Wet wiping cloths and dry wiping cloths, are not free of food debris and visible soil. Working containers of sanitizing solutions for storage of in-use wiping cloths are not used in a manner that prevents contamination of food, equipment, utensils, linens, or single-use articles. Place wiping cloths into sanitized solution prior to and after each use. Demonstrated proper set up of sanitizer for wiping cloths.

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Repair water leak from base of faucet at the hand wash sink in kitchen. Repair water leak at three compartment sink faucet.

**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

**44. PREMISES; PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Provide weather strip to base of rear door to make it vermin proof.

**Violation Description:** The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Replace damaged ceiling tiles. Provide cleaning to ceiling tiles and light covers.
	Not In Compliance	

**Violation Description:** The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>0</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Product was at 60°F for extended period of time. It was condemned for time temperature abuse. Twenty three whole chickens were discarded.

**Violation Description:** Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.
