


Violation Description: The pool shall be enclosed by one or a combination of the following: a fence; portion of a building; wall; or other approved durable enclosure. Doors, windows gates of living units or associated private premises shall not be permitted as part of the pool enclosure. The enclosure shall have a minimum effective perpendicular height of 5 feet. Openings, holes or gaps in the enclosure, doors and/or gates shall not allow the passage of a 4-inch diameter sphere. The enclosure shall be constructed over a hard and permanent material equivalent to concrete. The enclosure shall be designed and constructed so that it cannot be readily climbed by small children.

36K418 Water Quality - Cyanurates

POINTS 2	Compliance Date: Not Specified	Inspector Comments: Replace the missing signs: The name and address of facility, nearest emergency services telephone number. Provide the number on the pool capacity sign.

Violation Reference - CCR 24 - 3120B		

Violation Description: All signs shall have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches high, unless otherwise required, affixed to a wall, pole, gate or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all pool users. The following shall be posted:

- a) Maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool.
- b) "NO DIVING" at pools with a maximum water depth of 6 feet or less.
- c) Where no lifeguard service is provided, a warning sign shall be posted stating, "WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY." The sign also shall state in letters at least 1 inch high, "Children under the age of 14 shall not use pool without a parent or adult guardian in attendance."
- d) An illustrated diagram with text at least 1/4 inch high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures.
- e) The emergency telephone number 911 with numbers not less than 4 inches (102mm), the number of the nearest emergency services and the name and street address of the pool facility with numbers and text not less than 1 inch (25 mm) shall be posted.
- f) A warning sign for spa pools with "CAUTION" language.
- g) Where pools were constructed for which lighting was not required, a sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s) stating, "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK."
- h) A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP GATE CLOSED" or "KEEP DOOR CLOSED".
- i) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- j) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high shall be posted that describes the requirements for wave pools.
- k) A sign shall be posted at each spray ground and be visible from any part of the spray ground that states, "CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED. DO NOT DRINK."

36K430 Safety - Equipment/First Aid Kit

Violation Description: Every swimming pool shall be equipped for safety and rescue purposes with one or more rescue poles not less than 12 feet in length with body hooks, and one or more life rings having a minimum exterior diameter of 17 inches readily accessible for use. Such life rings shall have attached to them an 3/16 inch line long enough to span the maximum width of the pool. A first aid kit shall be provided at all swimming pools when required by DEHS.

36K444 Equipment - Recirculation Pump/Filter/Separation Tank

POINTS 2	Compliance Date: Not Specified	Inspector Comments: Identify and label the filters and the flow of the water thru the recirculation system on the pool piping by using arrows.

Violation Reference - HSC - 3120B, 3132B, 3141B		
Observed that when the filter is backwashed the wastewater bypasses the separation tank. Remove the rubber hose and reconnect the backwash line to the separation tank.		

Violation Description: Each pool shall be provided with a separate recirculation system designed for the continuous recirculation, filtration and disinfection of the pool water. The pumps, filters and all related parts of the pool water purification system shall be kept in operation whenever the pool is available for use. All parts of the pool and related pool facilities and equipment shall be maintained in good repair.

The backwash from a diatomaceous earth filter shall discharge into a separation tank. The wastewater from the separation tank shall discharge into a sanitary sewer or other disposal system acceptable to the local wastewater agency.

The direction of flow for the recirculation equipment shall be labeled clearly with directional symbols such as arrows on all piping in the equipment area.
