<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Measured prim rib cooked @ 10:30 AM holding @ 120 F in the hot holding drawer . Ensure potentially hazardous food hold @ 135 F and above . The person in charge adjusted the temperature to hold @ 135 and above.

Measured sour cream and butter holding at room temperature @ 76 F in small saucers at the baking potato serving station . Potentially hazardous food shall be held cold @ 41 F and below . See VC & D.

**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed no paper towels nor soap at the hand wash sink at the bar with a blender cup inside the hand wash sink. Keep all hand wash sinks properly stocked with soap and paper towels . Keep hand wash sinks clean ,clear and easily accessible for hand washing.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**14. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the dish washer at the bar not dispensing sanitizer (bleach) during inspection . Observed an empty sanitizer container . Corrected during inspection by replacing the empty sanitizer container with a new one. Facility operator shall maintain dish washer sanitizer concentration between 50-100 ppm.

Measured low concentration of sanitizer (QUAT) less than 200 ppm in sanitizer bucket at the food prep station. Maintain sanitizer concentration between 200-300 ppm.

Observed utensils coming out of the dishwasher in the back of the kitchen with traces of food debris . Ensure all utensils and equipment properly cleaned and sanitized.

**Violation Description:** All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)
