Inspector Comments: The Environmental Health Services received complaint alleging that an employee brings in cooked foods from home and serves them to patrons for money in exchange, and that some food items in the facility are not kept within their temperature legal limits.

Findings: The Manager maintained that the facility does not allow the sale of food prepared from outside the facility. Too, he said that pot luck among members are allowed. He also added that the facility cooks and serves food to patrons for money in the form of donations. Ensure that only food prepared in this facility or another approved food facility can be sold in this facility. Ensure that patrons do not exchange money for foods brought in during pot lucks. Food Temperatures in the facility were observed at their temperature legal limits.

Complaint is closed.
