Inspector Comments: Our department received a food-borne illness complaint allegedly resulted from eating of tacos. The complainant also added that the facility is filthy and that the restrooms smell bad. At the time of inspection, taco meat and already made tacos are observed at 49 degrees F inside the cold prep table. Maintain this taco meat and all other cold potentially hazardous food at 41 degrees F or below. A strand of human hair is observed inside the taco container in the cold prep table. As a reminder, food shall be prepared, stored, and served in a safe and sanitary manner at all times.

Violation Description: A foodborne illness complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.
