POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed employee wiping his hands in a cloth towel hanging on the side of the push cart used at the teppan grill . Food workers need to wash their hands properly @ the hand wash sink with warm water and soap.

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

Dishwasher don't know when the dishwasher stopped dispensing sanitizer . No one checked using the test strips. Facility operator need to sanitize in the 3 compartment sink using (QUAT) sanitizer until repairs takes place.

Observed mold build up in one of the soda guns and gun holder at the bar. Clean , sanitize and maintain.

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Measured low sanitizer (bleach) in the sanitizer bucket at the cook line and measured no sanitizer (bleach) at the bucket at the sushi station. Refresh sanitizer more often and use test strips to check for concentration (100-200 ppm).

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

Repair inoperable mechanical dishwasher and ensure sanitizer concentration between 50-100 ppm.
