Inspector Comments: The program of Environmental Health received a complaint that a customer became ill after consuming a grilled bbq chicken sandwich on 10/7/14. According to an employee, Jensen's stopped selling/cooking bbq the 1st weekend in October. He also stated their process is to cook the chicken and then shred it and cook it again. Employee was aware of the proper minimum internal cooking temperature for chicken (165F for 15 seconds) Also, a thermometer was properly calibrated by the employee during the complaint investigation. Measured an approved cooking temperature for beef during the inspection. Observed proper hot and cold holding temperatures for potentially hazardous food. Observed approved methods for food storage.
