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**5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY** **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed cook employee cleaning the food containers then proceeded with food preparing by changing gloves only. Discontinue this practice. Ensure to properly wash hands when changing gloves or changing from one task to another task that could potentially lead to contaminations. Employee was asked to thoroughly wash hands.

**Violation Description:** Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

**6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed no available paper towels at the the hand sink next to the ice machine. Observed a bucket of sanitizer inside the hand sink next to the coffee maker. Discontinue the use of hand sink for other purpose. Provide adequate hand sink supplies for all hand sink at all times and maintain the sinks clear and accessible for the purpose of hand washing.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Measured the top layer of chopped tomatoes mixed with onions (pico de gallo) holding in the cold table across from the cook line ranging between 48F - 54F. Observed taquitos holding in the hot holding table across from the cook line at 98F - 101F. Cook employee stated the taquito was cooked about an 30 minutes ago and the pico de gallo was placed in the cold holding unit about 90 minutes ago.
	Not In Compliance	

Cook immediately re-cooked the taquitos and relocated pico de gallo to the walk in cooler. Discontinue holding all potentially hazardous foods at unapproved temperatures.

**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

**30. FOOD STORAGE; FOOD STORAGE CONTAINERS IDENTIFIED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed containers of salt and cinnamon without label and stored without a lid on the top shelf (above eye-level) of the prep table (near the 3-compartment sink). Provide correct and proper label for all foods and provide a lid cover for foods stored above eye level to protect from all potential contamination.

**Violation Description:** Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

**39. THERMOMETERS PROVIDED AND ACCURATE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed missing thermometer in the milk reach in cooler and in the beef reach in cooler near the cook line. Provide thermometer for all coolers and place the thermometer at the warmest part of the cooler to ensure proper holding temperature is monitored.

**Violation Description:** An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)
