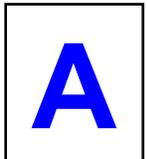

5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed an employee, with gloves on, prepping food items at the deli prep reach in area, sanitize the prep surface at this area, change their gloves, and then proceed to prep food items again without first washing their hands. All employees must conduct proper hand washing after changing tasks or before donning gloves.
	Complied on 1/21/2015	

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed multiple soiled wiping towels sitting out on non-food prep and food prep surfaces. Maintain all soiled wiping towels submerged within a sanitizer solution when not in immediate use.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

43. TOILET FACILITIES: PROPERLY CONSTRUCTED, SUPPLIED, CLEANED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed no available toilet paper within the employee restroom. Provide within the approved dispenser at all times.

Violation Description: Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary and in good repair for use by employees and patrons. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting, self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. Location of toilet facilities used by patrons shall not be located to pass through food preparation, food storage, or utensil washing areas. (114250, 114250.1, 114276)
