<b>POINTS</b> <b>3</b>	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Written proof on company or laboratory letterhead showing that the presterilized instruments have undergone a sterilization process was not provided by the artist. However, all observed needles and tattoo related instruments were properly sealed with manufacturer indicators stating Ethylene Oxide Gas was used for sterilization.
	Obtain sterilization documentation for all single-use sterilized instruments from the manufacturer.

**Violation Description:**

119315 (f) A body art facility that does not afford access to a decontamination and sterilization area that meets the standards of subdivision (c) of Section 119314 or that does not have sterilization equipment shall use only purchased disposable, single-use, presterilized instruments. In place of the requirements for maintaining sterilization records, the following records shall be kept and maintained for a minimum of 90 days following the use of the instruments at the site of practice for the purpose of verifying the use of disposable, single-use, presterilized instruments:

- (1) A record of purchase and use of all single-use instruments.
- (2) A log of all procedures, including the names of the practitioner and client and the date of the procedure. A record of purchase and use of all single-use instruments. A log of all procedures, including the names of the practitioner and client and the date of the procedure.
- (3) Written proof on company or laboratory letterhead showing that the presterilized instruments have undergone a sterilization process. Written proof shall clearly identify the instruments sterilized by name or item number and shall identify the lot or batch number of the sterilizer run.

119318 (c) The sponsor of a temporary body art event shall be responsible for ensuring the availability of support facilities and supplies for practitioners and vendors.

**Inspector Comments:**

Paper towel dispenser located near the procedure area was an unapproved type.

Install a touchless paper towel dispenser.

**Violation Description:**

119314 (b) (4) Procedure area shall be equipped with a sink, hot and cold running water, containerized liquid soap, and single-use paper towels dispensed from a wall-mounted, touchless dispenser that is readily accessible to the practitioner.

119314 (b) (5) All sinks shall be permanently plumbed and meet local building and plumbing codes. Facilities that were issued a permit prior to January 1, 2014, shall have until July 1, 2014, to comply with this section

119314 (c) (2) Decontamination and sterilization areas shall be equipped with a sink, hot and cold running water, containerized liquid soap, and single-use paper towels dispensed from a wall-mounted, touchless dispenser that is readily accessible to the practitioner.

119317 (g) (1) For temporary body art events consisting of one demonstration booth, the booth shall be equipped with hand washing equipment that, at a minimum, consists of containerized liquid soap, single-use paper towels, a five-gallon or larger container of potable water accessible via spigot, and a wastewater collection and holding tank of corresponding size. Potable water shall be refilled and the holding tank evacuated frequently to provide uninterrupted use, or as determined by the local enforcement agency.

119318 (b) (2) Restrooms that have flush toilets supplied with toilet paper, and hand wash sinks supplied with hot and cold potable running water, soap, and single-use paper towels to which practitioners have direct access.

The facility currently operates with a single artist and one apprentice. The artist David Hopkins is also the owner of the shop and is currently a San Bernardino County Registered Practitioner. The apprentice is currently completing a bloodborne pathogen exposure training; however is not performing any body art at this time. The shop does not have a decontamination area, therefore only uses pre-sterilized, single-use tattoo instruments.
