Inspector Comments: The reason for this visit is to investigate a complaint received by this Agency indicating that a cockroach was found on a customers food. The complaint was discussed with the owner. A thorough inspection was conducted at the facility and an active infestation was observed ongoing.

The Facility's Health Permit was Immediately suspended.

Your permit is hereby suspended due to an active cockroach infestation. Live cockroaches were observed behind both of the reach in coolers in the food preparation area. Immediately eliminate the infestation using an approved method. The facility shall remain closed until official notification is received by a representative of this Agency.

In order to have your permit reinstated please complete the following:

1. Eliminate the infestation using an approved method.
2. Remove all evidence of a pest infestation (dead cockroaches)
3. Clean and sanitize the affected areas.
4. Remove the accumulation of trash, grease, old food debris, and residue from the floors of the food preparation area.
5. Use of a pest control company is highly recommended.
