Inspector Comments: A follow-up inspection is being conducted on this date regarding a closure on 9-27-16 and as instructed from a 9-28-16 office hearing. This facility was closed for a cockroach infestation. Today several cockroaches, mainly baby cockroaches, were observed in different locations in the facility. The owner killed the cockroaches that were observed. After a thorough inspection, no more live cockroaches were observed. Continue to eliminate the cockroach infestation from this facility. Another follow-up inspection is scheduled for Wednesday, October 5th at 930am. The owner was also instructed to continue cleaning the entire facility. Utensils equipment etc. Also to empty trash at the end of every night. Since no more live cockroaches were observed, your facility is allowed to reopen. Continue to exterminate!

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
