Inspector Comments: You are hereby notified that your health permit is temporarily suspended due to an active rodent infestation. No sale of food or beverages will be allowed while the health permit is suspended.

- Clean and sanitize the affected areas.
- Eliminate all evidence of vermin.
- Maintain copies of pest control invoices/receipts.

Call Environmental Health Services at (800) 442-2283 for a follow up inspection when all vermin and evidence of vermin are eliminated from the facility. The facility must remain closed for at least 24 hours prior to the follow up inspection.

NOTE: Only the sale of food or beverages is not allowed while the health permit is suspended. This facility may sell non food or beverage items.

Violation Description: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by DEHS. Facility is to remain closed until permission from DEHS is given. Contact your inspector at your local office to schedule a reinspection to reinstate the health permit. Posted closed, do not move, hide, or remove sign.

Inspector Comments: A follow up inspection was conducted on this date to determine compliance of no vermin in the facility.

Observed the following:

- Rodent droppings underneath the shelves containing food items in the "Snack Zone"
- One (1) rodent dropping on top of a box of vegetable crackers
- One (1) rodent dropping on top of a box of honey graham crackers
- One(1) rodent dropping inside a box containing bagged pickles
- One (1) rodent dropping on top of a box of stuffing mix
- One (1) rodent dropping behind a box containing bags pretzels on a food display shelf
- Two (2) torn open packages of yellow rice with gnaw marks
- One (1) package of tortillas with yellow, liquid residue on the plastic packaging.

Observed several rodent droppings on the floor in the following areas of the back storage room:

- Underneath the wooden pallets
- Near the unused metal shelving
- Around the helium tanks.

Observed a pest control receipt dated 4/01/2021 stating that the pest control service observed signs of an active rodent infestation at the time of service. Upon questioning, the manager stated that pest control also serviced the facility on 4/10/2021. Unable to view the pest control invoice/receipt for this date at the time of inspection.

Upon questioning, the manager stated that the pest control service added metal wiring around the top of the wall in the back storage area and closed holes in the walls throughout the facility to prevent entry of vermin or vermin harborage.

The permit is suspended on this date due to an active rodent infestation. A follow up inspection is required prior to reopening the food and beverage portion of this facility.

The manager removed the visible rodent droppings on the food storage shelves and cleaned and sanitized the affected areas.

The manager blocked off the food and beverage areas in this facility and discontinued sales of food and beverages at this time.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.

16K013 Food in good condition, safe and unadulterated

Inspector Comments: Observed two (2) torn open packages of yellow rice with gnaw marks stored on a shelf containing food items intended for customer consumption.

Ensure that all food is in good, safe condition and free from adulteration.

The manager removed the two (2) packages of yellow rice and place them in an area intended for damaged products.

Violation Description: All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. Observed several rodent droppings on the floor in the following areas of the back storage room:

Clean and sanitize the affected areas and eliminate all evidence of vermin. Maintain the facility free of vermin at all times.

The manager removed the visible rodent droppings on the food storage shelves and cleaned and sanitized the affected areas.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

A follow up inspection was conducted on this date to determine compliance of no vermin in the facility.

The permit was suspended on this date due to an active rodent infestation.

NOTE: Only the sale of food of beverages is not allowed while the health permit is suspended. This facility may sell non food or beverage items.
