Inspector Comments: Charged re-reinspection conducted on this day to follow up a reinspection conducted on 3/4/2022. At that time, live nymph cockroaches were observed on floor beneath standing reach-in coolers. Permit remained suspended and facility closed at that time.

During re-reinspection:

- two(2) live nymph german cockroaches were observed on wall behind reach-in refrigerator
- two(2) live nymph german cockroaches were observed behind cooking equipment
- one(1) live adult german cockroach was observed on top of a reach-in cold holding unit
- one(1) live adult german cockroach was observed inside an empty ice machine
- several live adult and one(1) live nymph cockroach observed inside electrical outlet in the center of the kitchen area
- excessive food debris and food residue build-up observed beneath reach-in unit behind the front counter
- food debris and residue build-up observed below cooking equipment, reach-in cold holding unit, and electric outlets

Owner stated pest control serviced facility on 3/5/2022, however no invoice was observed at the time of re-reinspection.

Obtain proper pest control to treat facility. Clean and sanitize all affected areas prior to contacting EHS for reinspection. Permit remains suspended and facility closed.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
