Inspector Comments: PURPOSE:

A follow up inspection was conducted to verify that the repairs to the three compartment are sufficient for a permit reinstatement. It was noted during the follow up inspection that was conducted earlier in the day that the three compartment sink was clogged allowing water to back up into the sink. The three compartment sink was embargoed and with no approved method of sanitizing utensils the permit for the facility was suspended and the facility was closed.

OBSERVATION:

Observed new piping attached to the three compartment sink. Observed water to free draining with no signs of a clog. The owner was able to provide a receipt for a plumber.

OUTCOME:

The three compartment sink can now be put back into use and the embargoed sticker was removed. The permit for the facility is hereby reinstated and the facility may now reopen.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
