During this follow-up inspection, the following were observed:

- No rodent droppings at the previous areas of concern or other areas in the facility
- Some holes/gaps addressed in previous inspections were sealed but others were not sealed yet (see areas of concern below)

Observed areas of concern:

- Front door, 1/2" opening possible vermin entry point. seal and maintain
- Ceiling panel open located in 2nd floor storage room
- Facility trash bin open, keep closed to prevent vermin activity.

Instructed operator to provide a copy of the latest pest control report. Failure to comply may result in a charged reinspection.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
