Facility was observed closed upon arrival.

Findings:

- Vermin and evidence of vermin not observed in the facility.
- Observed silicon caulking around the following:
- Stainless steel walls behind equipment in cooks line.
- Stainless steel walls behind mop sink.
- Stainless steel walls behind dish washing area.
- Observed pest control service invoices from "Dixon Pest Control" for the dates: 9/17/19, 9/18/19, 9/25/19, 10/1/19, 10/8/19, and 10/15/19.
- Observed last pest control service receipt to state " No roach activity".

As per the owner of the facility, pest control service suggested to leave treatment on floor for a few days. Owner states four days after a treatment was done the floors were swept, mopped and sanitized with Clorox Bleach.

Owner instructed to ensure sanitizer level is a minimum of 100 PPM of chlorine when sanitizing floors after treatment.
