At that time, both live nymph and adult cockroaches were observed in various areas of facility. Permit was suspended and facility closed until vermin is eliminated. Facility was advised to clean and sanitize all affected areas once all evidence of vermin is eliminated from facility.

During reinspection no live or dead cockroaches were observed. Floors and surfaces observed clean and free of food debris. Pest control serviced facility latter part of 3/24/20 and visited site morning of reinspection as follow-up. Corrective action has been taken, eliminating vermin.
