

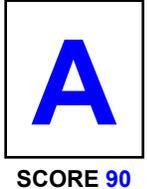

**Inspector Comments:** Observed empty soap and paper towel dispensers. Refill dispensers.

**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

**Inspector Comments:** Observed margarine with 5 grams trans fat stored in the walk-in refrigerator. Remove food items with more than 0.5 trans fat per serving. Corrected, items packed to be returned for store credit.

**Violation Description:** All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. (113967, 113976, 113980, 113988, 113990, 114035, 114254(c), 114254.3)

Observed torn prep refrigerator door seal in the cooks' line. Repair or replace door seal.

Observed damaged bottom of the prep refrigerator. Repair damaged bottom.

**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

### 41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES

**Inspector Comments:** Observed drain cups not installed for the soda guns in the bar. Provide and install drain cups, and plumb to a floor sink.

**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)



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**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114143 (d), 114266	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed broken base cove tiles in the cooks' line. Replace any broken or missing tiles.
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**Violation Description:** The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

**48. FOOD HANDLER CERTIFICATION**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - SBCC - 33.0409	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed 1 employee with no current San Bernardino County Food Worker Certification. Ensure that the employee obtains a San Bernardino County Food Worker card within 2 weeks. Provided Food Worker information and verification sheet to fill out and fax return. Failure to do so will result in a charged reinspection to verify compliance.
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**Violation Description:** This facility is currently in violation with the food handler certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food handlers must obtain a valid food handler certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food handler certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.

This facility operator must complete the "Missing Food Handler" form provided by the inspector and fax to 909-387-4272.
