

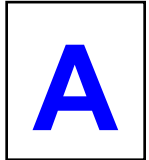

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54. PERMIT SUSPENSION

POINTS 0	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114409, 114405	Inspector Comments: Permit is suspended and facility closed on this day due to active waste water overflow in the floor sink underneath three compartment sink. Contact EHS for reinspection prior to opening for operation.
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Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)

5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Complied on 5/10/2022 Violation Reference -	Inspector Comments: Upon entering the facility, observed latex gloves being stored in the back storage room. Upon questioning person in charge stated they use the gloves for food preparation. Observed cashier with gloves being worn. Discontinue the use of latex in the facility and ensure all utensils are free of latex. Corrected on site; latex gloves were discarded.
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Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

14. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113984(e), 114097, 114099	Inspector Comments: (1) Observed the piercing tip of can opener to be covered in old food debris located across of ice machine. Ensure can opener is cleaned and sanitized and maintain all food contact surfaces clean and sanitized. (2) Observed wet, clean, tightly stacked pans above the three compartment sink. Discontinue this practice and ensure to allow pans to properly air dry after sanitation.
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Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

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22. SEWAGE AND WASTEWATER PROPERLY DISPOSED **MAJOR**

POINTS 4	<p>Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114197</p>	<p>Inspector Comments: Observed clear standing water with food residue in floor sink underneath three compartment sink. Upon questioning person in charge stated the standing water started to happen earlier in day. Upon releasing one compartment full of water floor sink over flowed.</p> <p>Take the necessary steps to repair/replace floor drain to allow proper drainage and maintain all floor sinks in good condition.</p> <p>A follow up inspection will be conducted at a later date to verify compliance.</p> <p>See permit suspended violation for more information.</p>
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Violation Description: All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system. (114197) Toilet facilities must be operable.

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

POINTS 1	<p>Compliance date not specified Complied on 5/10/2022 Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1</p>	<p>Inspector Comments: Observed wet wiping towels stored in chlorine sanitizer solution at 50 parts per million.</p> <p>Maintain chlorine sanitizer solution above 100parts per million.</p> <p>Corrected on site; employee adjusted level of sanitizer to 100 parts per million.</p>
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Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES

POINTS 1	<p>Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114171, 114189.1</p>	<p>Inspector Comments: (1) Observed a missing air gap between the three compartment sink and floor sink.</p> <p>Observed a missing air gap between the ice machine drainage line and floor sink.</p> <p>Provide at least a one inch air gap or twice the diameter of the pipe, whichever is greater, between floor sinks and water supply.</p> <p>(2) Observed a small leak underneath the rear preparation sink.</p> <p>Repair or replace and ensure all plumbing fixtures in good repair.</p>
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Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

IMPORTANT: Risk Based Inspection Frequency

Food facilities that pose a higher risk level for causing foodborne illness will be subject to an additional inspection, to be billed at the hourly rate as provided in the San Bernardino County Code [Schedule of Fees](#). Facilities that received one or more of the following will be elevated to a high risk tier:

- A score letter of "C" or lower on one of the last two graded inspections,
- A score letter of "B" on two of the last three graded inspections,
- Repeated "four (4) point violation Risk Factor" (critical violation codes 1-23) on the last two inspections, or
- Four (4) or more critical violations (codes 1-23) noted during an inspection, or
