Inspector Comments: Environmental Health has received a complaint stating requester has observed rats in the facility.

On 5/3/2016 a complaint investigation was conducted regarding a rodent infestation complaint. Numerous droppings were observed throughout the dry food storage area. In addition, numerous packages of dry food were observed to be open and torn as a result of the rodent infestation. Observed many rat traps throughout dry storage area. Numerous packages of dry food storage was voluntarily discarded by manager see (VC&D). See violation descriptions.

A routine inspection was also conducted at this facility on this date and a re-inspection has been scheduled for 5/5/2016.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

16K023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

Inspector Comments: Observed numerous droppings and rat traps throughout the dry food storage. Droppings were found on dry food storage areas that contained powdered foods such as flour, dog food, cookies, crackers, candy, and nuts.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Inspector Comments: Health permit suspended due to rodent infestation. Notice of Closure sign posted. Do no remove closure sign until a reinspection has been conducted and authorization has been give to reopen facility.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)

- 1 package of oreo cookies
- 6 packages of fig newtons
- 11 pre- packaged goldfish containers

- 24 packages of pepperidge farm cookies.

Description: Operator has voluntarily consented to the condemnation and destruction of food as said material being unfit for human consumption or otherwise in violation of California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 5, Chapter 1 through 8, the disposition of which is provided for by Chapter 8, Article 3, Section 111895.

Re-inspection will be conducted within two days. Failure to comply will result in future charged re-inspections of \$245 per hour with a 1/2 hour minimum.
