**Inspector Comments:** RE: Re-inspection

This re-inspection is conducted to verify elimination of rodents from the facility and also to verify leaking roof/ceiling repairs in the facility. The facility was ordered closed and the permit to operate was suspended on 3/7/19 due to active rats/rodents infestation. A supervisory review compliance agreement was conducted at 10:00 am today in our office.

At the time of inspection today, 3 old rats droppings are observed in the storage area. The owner stated that the Slugg Bugg Pest Control services came to treat the facility for rodents and other vermin on 3/8/19. Observed the receipt of services dated 3/8/19. The owner added that the pest control company will come for another treatment on 3/15/19 and that the services will continue on a weekly basis or as needed. The display shelves in the retail area have been thoroughly cleaned.

The owner stated that the leaking roof/ceiling have been repaired. Most water-damaged ceiling tiles have been replaced. Replace the few remaining water-damaged ceiling tiles.

The facility can now re-open for business.

**Description:** Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
