Inspector Comments: RE: Rodent Infestation Complaint

Our department received a complaint of a mouse eating out of the chips bags with holes in them. The complainant stated that the same complaint was made previously to a female manager. The complainant added that during another recent visit to the facility, mice droppings are still observed in the chips aisle and bags of chips are being gnawed on by mice.

The complaint is valid. Mice droppings are observed in the chips aisle and in the back storage area. Observed a bag of popcorn being gnawed on. Photos taken. The same violation/complaint was addressed on 5/7/18. Due to imminent health hazard, the permit to operate the facility is hereby suspended and the food section of the facility is hereby ordered closed. Closed sign posted. The permittee has the right to a hearing if requested within 15 calendar days of the receipt of this notice to show cause why the permit to operate should not be suspended or revoked.

Note: A Supervisory Review meeting is hereby scheduled for Monday, 7/2/18, at 10:00 am in our office: 385 N. Arrowhead Ave, 2nd Floor, San Bernardino, CA 92415. A representative of the facility (Family Dollar) is expected to be at the meeting.
