Inspector Comments: During a plan check TOO inspection, observed the following critical violations warranting facility closure:

- 1 live cockroach on the floor next to soda syrup dispensing station
- 2 live cockroaches on the wall behind clean dish storage rack
- 1 live nymph cockroach on the wall on the left hand side of 3 compartment sink.
- 1 dead cockroach underneath 2 door refrigerator in rearmost storage room
- 2 cockroach eggs on the left hand side corner of 3 compartment sink.

You are hereby notified that your health permit is temporarily suspended due to an active cockroach infestation.

- Remove/eliminate all evidence of the cockroaches using an approved method of pest control as soon as possible.
- Seal all gaps/crevices in the facility
- Clean and sanitize the affected areas.

All evidence of cockroach activity must be eliminated from the facility prior to reopening. The facility must remain closed for at least 24 hours prior to reopening.

Call Environmental Health Services at (800) 442-2283 for a reinspection prior to reopening the facility.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
