Observed the following during this complaint inspection:

1. Rodent droppings under chip bags in front of store.
2. Rodent droppings by Pringles cans.
3. rodent droppings on floor and wood bundles by back door.
4. rodent droppings under three compartment sink.
5. Mouse X The Effective Control of Mice bag in back of facility.
6. fallen ceiling in back of facility.
7. Rodent dropping by box of alcohol bottles.
8. Dead mouse on sticky trap under wine shelf.
9. No food products appeared to be adulterated during this inspection.

Instructed the owner that the following needs to happen prior to reopening facility:

1. Facility is closed for a minimum of 24 hours to allow for treatment and clean-up.

3. Rodent droppings must be cleaned up so that it can be determined if there is a new infestation.
