



POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114000	Inspector Comments: Observed a container of half and half at customer self service area without any time/timer for discard. Ensure all potentially hazardous food under time as a public health control are marked with the appropriate time for discard. According to employees, the half and half was removed from temperature control 20 minutes prior to start of inspection. Corrective Action: Operator voluntarily discarded the half and half. See#52
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Violation Description: When time only, rather than time and temperature is used as a public health control, records and documentation must be maintained. Food must be marked or otherwise identified as to what time the food was removed from temperature control. (114000) Food items shall not exceed the time marked. (114000)

Observed wet wiping cloths stored in turbid water in a red bucket near the customer pick up area. 2. Observed wet wiping cloths stored in 100ppm quat. 1. Immediately discard sanitizing solutions whenever they become turbid. 2. Maintain quat sanitizing solutions at 200-300ppm
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Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)
