NATURE OF THE COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that the facility has a cockroach infestation.

OBSERVATION:

The person in charge was not aware of this complaint. She stated that the facility has not had any vermin issues since the summer when they started receiving routine pest control treatments. Observed dead cockroaches in the rear of the facility see violation 16C023.

NOTE: A routine inspection was also conducted on this date and should be referenced to for violations that do not pertain to this complaint,

OUTCOME:

No further action is warranted at this time and the complaint will be closed.

The operator was encouraged to continue with the current pest control treatments and immediately remove any remnants of pest from the facility.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
