**Inspector Comments:** A follow up inspection was conducted on this date by the San Bernardino County Division of Environmental Health to verify compliance in regards to active rodent infestation closure from complaint inspection.

Facility was observed closed upon arrival.

Observed numerous rodent droppings in the back storage area in the following locations:

- Behind pallets closest to wall area.
- In between flooring cracks.
- Underneath employee break area.
- Few fresh rodent droppings on pallet and behind a pallet.

Also observed several rodent droppings on shelving near easter candy.

Manager stated that pest control came the day prior to second inspection to service facility for infestation. Observed receipt of pest control service.

Due to the numerous rodent droppings in facility and fresh droppings present, an active infestation is still observed. Permit is to remain suspended.

Provide thorough cleaning and sanitize affected areas. Eliminate all evidence of vermin from facility.

**Description:** Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
