



Suction Outlet covers (anti-entrapment covers over main drains and skimmer equalizer outlets) shall be replaced upon expiration. The expiration (in years) is stamped on the front of each cover, indicating the amount of time the cover is valid after installation. Each replacement cover shall:

- Meet the latest ANSI/APSP-16 performance standard
- Be rated for the maximum designed flow-rate of the pump

Retain all records which indicate the make/model number of the replacement cover and date of installation. Records shall be made available to your inspector upon request.

**36K540 Enclosure – Critical – Gates and doors self-closing and self-latching** ⚠ CRITICAL ⚠

**Inspector Comments:** Observed gate of only entrance/exit of pool enclosure not self-latching. Gate must be opened to almost 90 degrees before gate will latch. Repair/replace gate to ensure gate self-closes and self-latches.

Note: Gate was ajar upon arrival. Per management company, parts to fix gate arrived today and gate will be fixed tomorrow.

**Violation Description:** Gates and doors shall be equipped with self-closing and self-latching devices. Gates and doors shall be capable of being locked during times when the pool is closed. The self-latching device shall keep the gate or door securely closed. Gates and doors shall open outwardly away from the pool except where otherwise prohibited by law. The pool enclosure shall have at least one means of egress without a key for emergency purposes. The enclosure shall be constructed so that all persons will be required to pass through common pool enclosure gates or doors in order to gain access to the pool area. All gates and doors exiting the pool area shall open into a public area or a walkway accessible by all patrons of the pool.

**Violation Description:** All signs shall have clearly legible letters or numbers not less than 4 inches high, unless otherwise required, affixed to a wall, pole, gate or similar permanent structure in a location visible to all pool users. The following shall be posted:

- a) Maximum number of pool users permitted for each pool.
- b) "NO DIVING" at pools with a maximum water depth of 6 feet or less.
- c) Where no lifeguard service is provided, a warning sign shall be posted stating, "WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY." The sign also shall state in letters at least 1 inch high, "Children under the age of 14 shall not use pool without a parent or adult guardian in attendance."
- d) An illustrated diagram with text at least 1/4 inch high of artificial respiration and CPR procedures.
- e) The emergency telephone number 911 with numbers not less than 4 inches (102mm), the number of the nearest emergency services and the name and street address of the pool facility with numbers and text not less than 1 inch (25 mm) shall be posted.
- f) A warning sign for spa pools with "CAUTION" language.
- g) Where pools were constructed for which lighting was not required, a sign shall be posted at each pool entrance on the outside of the gate(s) stating, "NO USE OF POOL ALLOWED AFTER DARK."
- h) A sign shall be posted on the exterior side of gates and doors leading into the pool enclosure area stating, "KEEP GATE CLOSED" or "KEEP DOOR CLOSED".
- i) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high and in a language or diagram that is clearly stated shall be posted at the entrance area of a public pool which states that persons having currently active diarrhea or who have had active diarrhea within the previous 14 days shall not be allowed to enter the pool water.
- j) A sign in letters at least 1 inch high shall be posted that describes the requirements for wave pools.
- k) A sign shall be posted at each spray ground and be visible from any part of the spray ground that states, "CAUTION: WATER IS RECIRCULATED. DO NOT DRINK."

**36K554 Equipment - Pressure/Vacuum gauge requirements**

**Violation Description:** A pressure and vacuum gauge shall be provided for each pump system. Each gauge shall have a scale range approximately 1 ¼ times the maximum anticipated working pressure or vacuum and shall be accurate within 2 percent of scale. The pressure gauge located on the filter shall be marked with the clean start up pressure reading.

**36K562 Skimmers - Pool skimming systems**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance Date: Not Specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed water level in pool almost below water line. Ensure water level in pool is high enough to allow skimmers to function properly.

		Observe skimmer baskets full of debris. Ensure baskets are cleaned frequently.

**Violation Description:** The pool shall be equipped with one or more skimming methods to provide continuous skimming of the pool water and shall be capable of continually withdrawing not less than 100 percent of the flow rate. Each surface skimmer shall comply with the requirements in accordance with section 3136B, Title 24, California Code of Regulations.



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**36K576 Maintenance – Operation/Incident records**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance Date: Not Specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed operation records not maintained. Last entry observed was on 6/29. Ensure daily records are kept of all test results and actions taken at pool site.

**Violation Description:** The pool operator shall maintain a written daily record of all test results, equipment readings, calibrations, and corrective action taken at the public pool site. [This includes daily records of pH, disinfectant level, and water temperature. If used, cyanuric acid concentration shall be tested monthly.]

If a fecal, vomit, blood contamination, near-drowning, or drowning incident occurs in a pool, the pool operator shall record the incident in accordance with the requirements of [Health and Safety Code] section 65546 and shall identify the affected public pool in the incident record if there is more than one pool at the public pool site. This record shall be maintained at the public pool site.

**36K582 Maintenance - Public pool site maintenance**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance Date: Not Specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed picture frame used to hold Pool/Spa permit with glass shattered. Remove broken glass from pool enclosure to prevent glass from falling in to pool or onto deck.

**Violation Description:** The pool operator shall keep all parts of the public pool site well-maintained, including, but not limited to, the public pools, water treatment systems, ancillary facilities, signs, showers, toilets, dressing facilities, drinking fountains, diaper-changing stations, floors, walls, partitions, doors, and lockers.

**36K596 Permit - Public Pool Closure**

Unhealthful, unsafe, or unsanitary conditions include, but are not limited to, failure to maintain clean pool water and clear pool water requirements; inadequate disinfection; improper pH; the presence of inhalation hazards; failure to meet microbiological or chemical water-quality standards; missing or broken suction outlet covers; missing or broken pool enclosures, including fencing and gates; hazards to pool users; and any other violation of these regulations identified by the enforcing agent. A public pool shall not be reopened until the unhealthful, unsafe, or unsanitary condition has been rectified and upon specific written approval from the enforcing agent.
