Nature of complaint: Complaint stated Refrigerated and freezer units have products that are months past expiration dates, foul odor coming from the refrigerated unit are so strong as to repel you from opening the door.

Interview: Upon interview, manager stated he was aware of complaint and they have cleaned the inside of the refrigerator.

Observations: Upon inspection, there was no foul odor coming from the refrigerator. All the old food had been discarded a week prior during their routine inspection. All food observed was in good conditions and non-expired.

Result: Manager was advised to ensure all food is inspected daily, and to remove food that is rotten.

No further action required at this time. Complaint is now closed.
