#### 16K999 Complaint Inspection

Inspector Comments: A compliant was received by Environmental Health Services on 10/06/2021.

Reference - HSC

Complainant stated the following:

- Rodent droppings in the following areas: in the condiments, kitchen area, ice machine and cabinets for dead mice.
- Operating a snack shop.

Findings upon questioning, person in charge stated the following:

- Have not heard of this complaint nor received similar complaints.
- Facility conducts their own pest control and cleaning.
- Has a snack shop and sells prepackaged food items (candy, ice cream, bottled beverage), hot chocolate/coffee/latte machine drinks.

Observations on this date:

- "Snack Shop" building located east of the main kitchen.
- "Snack Shop" to sell non-prepackaged hot chocolate/coffee/latte drinks from a Nestle beverage machine; prepackaged food items like ice cream bars, candy, chips and beverages.
- "Snack Shop" facility has a hand washing sink and a three compartment sink.
- Main kitchen to have old droppings in the following areas: along the floor and wall edges of the dish washing area, on the floor in the cabinets of the beverage stations near the dining hall.

Results: Facility shall submit plans for "Snack Shop" within 72 hours. An application for plan review was sent to staff on site; the application and guidelines are also available on the San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services website under "Plan Check." Contact the office at 800-442-2283 and ask for Plan Checker of the Day for more details. Re-inspection will be conducted November 10, 2021. Non-compliance may result in future billable inspections. This complaint is closed.

#### 16K023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

Inspector Comments: Observed old rodent pellets in the following areas:

Not In Compliance

- Along the edges of the floor/wall meets in the dish washing area.
- In the cabinets of the beverage drinks of the dining hall.

Violation Reference - HSC - 114259.1, 114259.4, 11425

Eliminate rodent droppings, clean and sanitize the affected areas. Ensure to keep the facility vermin free and take the necessary proactive and preventative measures to prevent further activity including conducting some type of pest control service for the facility. A re-inspection will be conducted on or after November 10, 2021 to ensure compliance. Failure to eliminate the rodent pellets will result in billable re-inspections.

Re-inspection will be conducted November 10, 2021.

**Violation Description:** Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
