All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

39. THERMOMETERS PROVIDED AND ACCURATE

Inspector Comments: Observed missing thermometer in pizza prep refrigerator.
Ensure that all hot and cold holding units have accurate thermometers.

Violation Description: An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

Inspector Comments: Observed a wet wiping cloth on top of pizza prep table.
Store all multi-use wiping cloths in sanitizer bucket between each use.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN

Inspector Comments: Observed cracks/crevices on wall behind mop sink, behind oven, and near hand washing sink.
Repair so that walls and floors are smooth and easily cleanable.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

48. FOOD WORKER CERTIFICATION

Inspector Comments: Observed 1 invalid food handler card.
Only San Bernardino County food handler cards are valid.
Fax the completed missing food worker card sheet to 90-9-387-4272 within 14 days to avoid a charged inspection.

Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
