Inspector Comments: A complaint investigation was conducted regarding a complaint received by Environmental Health on 8-18-16. In the complaint, the complainant stated that live and dead cockroaches and flies were observed at Nissi Meat Market during a consultation inspection. Owner of Nissi Meat Market and prospective owner of facility was present during inspection and notified regarding complaint when issues observed.

16K023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

Violation Reference - HSC - 114259.1, 114259.4, 11425

Inspector Comments: Observed several live and dead brown-banded or German cockroaches in adjoined meat-cutting and prepackaged food areas and in area with unused equipment. Observed dozens of live flies throughout facility and several sticky traps located immediately above equipment (meat case, microwave, prep sink) containing dead or dying flies.

Eliminate vermin from facility and maintain free of vermin. Recommend obtaining services of licensed pest control service. Reinspection required to verify compliance.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Inspector Comments: Observed large openings around north-facing exterior doors. Observed several pieces of unused equipment throughout facility.

Seal any openings around doors to prevent entry of vermin. Remove all unused equipment from premises to prevent vermin harborage.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)
