**Inspector Comments:** The purpose of this visit is to conduct a follow up inspection regarding rodent droppings noted in a complaint investigation conducted 8/9/2018.

The following observations were made at this time:

The Fry Factory was found to be free of rodent droppings, and no evidence of an active rodent infestation was observed. A solid well sealed door was installed at the entryway where the door had previously been removed and replaced with a mesh screen.

In the Snack Shack, 5 visibly old rat droppings were found during reinspection. 2 on the floor behind the small soda fountain, 1 on the counter beside the table top soda fountain, and 2 on the shelf behind the table top soda fountain. At this time employees cleaned and sanitized affected areas which were missed during the initial cleaning. No further evidence of a rodent infestation was observed.

Maintain food facilities free of all vermin and pests. Maintain food facilities in a clean and sanitary manner.

No further action required at this time. Complaint is closed.
