Inspector Comments: Observed one live german roach in facility away from kitchen area. No contamination of food observed.

Ensure facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence.

**Violation Description:** The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

#### Overall Inspection Comments

On January 6th, 2021 the permit for this facility was suspended due to an active roach infestation. Approximately 40-70 live german roaches of all life stages were observed in the back dish washing room.

On this date one live roach was observed throughout the facility. No other observation of roaches were observed or contamination of food was observed. Operator provided pest control report dated 1/5/21 stating facility had been treated for roaches.

A one-week follow-up will be conducted to verify facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence.
