Inspector Comments: A re-opening inspection was conducted this date after the facility owner participated in a Supervisory Review at the Division of Environmental Health offices on 3/19/2019 that was scheduled as a result of the facility receiving a score below 79 on a mandated re-score inspection.

On this date the following was observed:

- The facility was observed cleaned including the floors, counter tops, refrigeration units and microwave.
- The access panel in the storage room was closed.
- New scoops with designated handles were provided for the bulk food items in the dry storage area.
- No food handling was occurring at the time of the re-opening inspection due to the facility closure, however, proper food handling procedures were reviewed and stressed to the operator.
- The new base paint coat in the kitchen was observed to not be an approved finish. The facility shall paint the walls with a semi gloss or high gloss finish to facilitate cleaning.
- Dunnage racks were observed in the dry storage area to maintain food 6 inches above the ground.
- The hole in the wall behind the food preparation sink was observed repaired.
- Chemical spray bottles and stored food in the fridge were observed labeled.

The facility is conditionally reopened and the permit to operate is reinstated.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
