Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to conduct a complaint investigation inspection.

NATURE OF COMPLAINT:

The complainant stated there was a rat chewing food boxes in the aisle. Complainant also stated that there was rat pee covering bagged food and rat pee stains on food.

FINDING(S):

The manager stated that they have not heard of this nor any similar complaint. According to the manager pest control services facility four to five times a week and pest control was on site the day prior to inspection. Manager stated that they have been sanitizing and inspecting all merchandise being placed onto floor for customer sale.

OBSERVATION(S):

- Observed pest control receipts dated 3/16/21, 3/17/21, 3/18/21, 3/19/21 and 3/23/21. Receipts dated 3/16/21-3/19/21 state no evidence of activity observed. Receipt dated 3/23/21 stated that new droppings were observed and roofing insulation of back storage area is to be removed. Manager stated that date on receipt is incorrect and pest control receipt is from day prior to inspection.
- Observed six dried rodent droppings on bottom shelf below candy storage racks.
- Observed one dried rodent dropping on box of chips in back storage area.
- Observed food kept in good condition, no adulteration of food observed.

RESULT(S):

Clean and sanitize areas affected and eliminate evidence of rodent droppings. Maintain copies of pest control receipts.

A follow up inspection will be conducted in 24 hours to verify compliance.

NOTE: If there is evidence of rodent droppings during follow up inspection food portion of facility will be closed.

(114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
