Inspector Comments: Your health permit is suspended due to vermin (rat / rodent) infestation.

Since you no longer have a health permit, you are directed to cease all food sales until approved to do so by our department. Further food sales is a violation of county ordinance without a valid health permit.

Correction will require that you eliminate all live rats and eliminate all rat entry points and clean and sanitize all horizontal surfaces, including floors, window sills and table tops.

By March 25, 2020, you must call our office at 1-800-442-2283 to give an update on the status of the infestation and a time estimate when you think all corrective measures have been completed. While not required, it is strongly recommended that you obtain the assistance of an experienced pest control company and follow their recommendation.

When you believe you are have completed the required steps to eliminate the infestation, removed all fecal pellets and sanitize the facility, you may request a reinspection. Only if we verify that these steps have been taken during this reinspection will we restore your permit and allow you to sell food.

Violation Description: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by DEHS. Facility is to remain closed until permission from DEHS is given. Contact your inspector at your local office to schedule a reinspection to reinstate the health permit. Posted closed, do not move, hide, or remove sign.

Inspector Comments: On March 18, 2020, our office received a complaint regarding your facility. In the complaint, the complainant alleged that he / she observed "mouse droppings" on tables and window sills inside your facility.

Observations:

Observed numerous rodent (rat) fecal pellets on tables, window sills and under / around the vending machines. Also observed pistachio nut hulls and old raisins littering the floor between two vending machines. No live or dead rodents were observed during the investigation.

The facility's health permit was suspended during the investigation and the food portion of the operation closed.

(114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. Overall Inspection Comments

Permit suspended. All food sales prohibited. NOTE: By County ordinance, it is illegal to sell food without a valid health permit. Your permit has been suspended. You may not sell food until your permit is restarted.

Closure notice posted. No observed grade card to remove.

Do not remove or obstruct closure notice. It can only be removed by a member of the San Bernardino Department of Public Health, Environmental Health division.

You must contact our department at 1-800-442-2283 within twenty-four (24) hours with a status report as to how your are going to eliminate your rodent infestation.
