Inspector Comments: Observed hot water valve not operating at restroom. Provide warm water (100F) at handwashing sink.

Violation Description: An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113953(c), 114099.2(b) 114101(a), 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)

Inspector Comments: Observed raw beef stored above deli ham, lettuce, and tomatoes in refrigerator. Store raw animal products below ready-to-eat and produce items.

Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

Inspector Comments: Observed drain plug damaged for 3-compartment sink. Replace drain plug. Ensure basins can be plugged properly for dish washing.

Observed lack of sanitizer test strips. Provide appropriate test strips to check sanitizer levels.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE

Inspector Comments: Observed single-use forks stored with tines facing up. Store utensils with handles facing up to prevent contamination.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

Inspector Comments: Observed wet wiping cloth on prep table. Store wiping cloths in approved sanitizer.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)



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41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed hose attached to spigot without backflow preventer at 3-compartment sink. Install backflow prevention device or maintain at least 1-inch air gap between sprayer nozzle and flood rim.

Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

43. TOILET FACILITIES: PROPERLY CONSTRUCTED, SUPPLIED, CLEANED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed toilet paper out of dispenser. Store toilet paper in approved dispenser.

Violation Description: Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary and in good repair for use by employees and patrons. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting, self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. Location of toilet facilities used by patrons shall not be located to pass through food preparation, food storage, or utensil washing areas. (114250, 114250.1, 114276)

44. PREMISES; PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Observed operator leave drive-thru window open and unattended. Maintain window closed when not in use or install air curtain to prevent entry of vermin.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)
