On this date no rodent droppings were observed. All gaps observed during the routine inspection were covered. Person in charge stated all areas had been cleaned and sanitized.

Upon arrival facility was observed closed.

The health permit for this facility has been reinstated, this facility may now operate.

Action Required: Maintain facility clean and in a sanitary manner.

A one week reinspection will be conducted to verify compliance.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.
