Operator showed proof of pest control invoices and stated pest control had visited prior to inspection. Observed Dewey sticky traps throughout the facility. Operator stated all hole and cracks asked to be sealed and repaired from last inspection visit had been corrected.

Observed the following vermin activity throughout the facility:

- Two(2) adolescent German cockroaches near the cooking line
- One (1) nymph German cockroach near the drink dispenser
- Two(2) German cockroach eggs under front lobby snack area and under table near the ice machine
- One (1) adult german cockroach peaking out from corner of the ceiling

Eliminate all signs of cockroach infestation, clean and sanitize all infected areas. Ensure facility is maintained free of vermin.

A follow up billed re-inspection will be conducted at a later date.
