



POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Ensure handwash sinks are free and clear from any obstructions and are for handwashing purposes only. Observed food debris inside of the handwash sink. Corrected on site.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Maintain potentially hazardous hot food at 135F or above. Observed fried chicken on buffet line with an internal temperature between 107F-120F. Operator discarded chicken. See VC&D.

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Repair/replace standing cooler to provide proper temperatures of 41F or below for potentially hazardous cold foods. Remove and do not store potentially hazardous foods in unit until repaired. Observed cooked chicken and raw egg dip with an internal temperature of 53F in the cold holding unit on left side of kitchen. Operator discarded chicken and raw egg batter. See VC&D.

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified	Inspector Comments: Provide a one inch air gap to prevent backflow contamination. Observed pipe line from soda machine drain below the rim of the floor sink.

Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)
