Inspector Comments: A follow-up inspection was conducted on this date following a facility closure.

On 5/27/22 the facility was closed during a follow-up billable inspection due to an active vermin infestation.

During the closure the inspector observed the following:

1. Old rodent droppings were observed three to four (3-4) under the two-compartment sink
2. Observed one(1) live adult German cockroaches near the meat slicer under the hood.
3. Observed dead German cockroaches in the following areas:
 - Two (2) nymph under the upright refrigerator unit near the cooling rack
 - Three to four (3-4) nymph under the grill
 - Four to five (4-5) eggs under the grill
 - One (1) nymph under the meat slicer
 - Two (2) on the floor near floor sink under prewash sink

On this date the following was observed:

1. Two old rodent droppings were observed on bottom shelf of table next to cold holding unit in the kitchen
2. Observed one(1) live nymph German cockroaches near kitchen handwash sink
3. Observed dead German cockroaches in the following areas:
 - Two (2) nymph and adult in cabinet below the coffee machine by front service counter.
 - One (1) adult under the door on the east side of the kitchen.
 - Two (2) on the floor near floor sink under prewash sink

A billable reinspection will be conducted on or after 6/7/22 to verify facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence. Failure to comply may result in another billable re-inspection at an hourly rate of \$245 with 30-minute minimum charge.

- Observed dead German cockroaches in the following areas:
 - Two (2) nymph and adult in cabinet below the coffee machine by front service counter.
 - One (1) adult under the door on the east side of the kitchen.
 - Two (2) on the floor near floor sink under prewash sink

Eliminate all evidence of vermin in the facility. Clean and sanitize the affected area.

A billable reinspection will be conducted on or after 6/7/22 to verify facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence. Failure to comply may result in another billable re-inspection at an hourly rate of \$245 with 30-minute minimum charge.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

A follow up inspection was conducted on this date to verify facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence.

On this date one live nymph, and approximately 6 dead adult roaches were observed.

A billable reinspection will be conducted on or after 6/7/22 to verify facility is free of vermin and vermin evidence. Failure to comply may result in another billable re-inspection at an hourly rate of \$245 with 30-minute minimum charge.
